ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

As a rule, for admission to our 6UWXY`cf dfc[fUa a Yg you will need:

- A diploma that is equivalent to the Dutch Secondary Education Diploma, which gives you access to higher education.
- An official English test that is equivalent to an IELTS score of 6.0.

The closing date for application is 15 June for non-EU students and 15 July for EU-students.

COSTS
